**Subject: EQUIVALENCE OF LEVEL-3 DIPLOMA BY CITY & GUILDS**

Reference email dated 31-08-2020 on the subject noted above, it is stated that;

- Inter Board Committee of Chairmen in 154<sup>th</sup> IBCC meeting resolved that the City & Guilds Level-3 qualification is equivalent to DAE/HSSC (Pre-Engg. Group) of Pakistan provided that the candidates pass three courses i.e. “Applied Physics”, “Applied Chemistry” & “Mathematics” from any BTE of Pakistan.
- The City & Guilds is offering following trades / technologies for level -3 qualifications.
  - Diplomas in Engineering (Welding) (2850-85)
  - Diplomas in Engineering (Fabrication) (2850-86)
  - Diplomas in Engineering (Fabrication & welding) (2850-87)
  - Diplomas in Engineering (Maintenance Installation & commissioning) (2850-88)
  - Diplomas in Engineering (Mechanical Manufacturing Engineering) (2850-89)
  - Diplomas in Engineering (Electrical & Electronics Engineering) (2850-90)

In response to it, PBTE worked out modalities to accommodate Level-3 diploma holders and got modalities approved by the Board. The detail is as under;

1. The registration of the students shall be forwarded by City & Guilds or their specified centers / institutes.
2. The training of practicals of Physics and Chemistry for the bridge courses shall be imparted by City & Guilds approved centers and PBTE will conduct the examinations of practicals accordingly.


**Note:** The formative assessment i.e. sessional marks shall be excluded.

4. City & Guilds Level-3 pass out students with SSC (Science Group) may be informed about the holding and commencement of examinations of bridge courses, initially by advertising both at print media and at PBTE website and other social media of PBTE for proper registration with PBTE. However, the registration / examination schedule may be uploaded at Boards website prior to the commencement of registration / examination activities every year for the general awareness of the students.
5. The detail course contents / model question papers for the Bridge courses of Level-3 Diploma of City & Guilds shall be uploaded on PBTE's website for the facility of students.
6. The students shall be registered with PBTE through City & Guilds till one month before the commencement of 1st Annual examination every year. However, in case of no response from City & Guilds, the students may approach directly to PBTE for registration purpose.
7. PBTE shall conduct the examinations twice a year along with 1st Annual and 2nd Annual examinations every year.
8. The candidates of City & Guilds shall have to submit Rs. 5000/- for registration and Rs. 7000/- for examination and certification.
9. The Schemes of Studies shall be computerized with nomenclature titled "Bridge Courses for Level-3 Diploma of City & Guilds".
10. The intake / pre-requisite for registration purpose shall be complied with true letter & spirit as per decision of IBCC i.e. City & Guilds Level-3 pass out students with SSC (Science Group) only.
11. A candidate failing in one or more bridge subjects shall be allowed to appear in those subjects only in forthcoming examinations and the candidate has to pass his/her all subjects of bridge courses in four (04) forthcoming subsequent consecutive examinations (1st Annual / 2nd Annual).
12. In case he / she fails to pass all the subjects in four (04) forthcoming consecutive examinations, the registration of the candidate will remain intact and the candidate will reappear in all subjects of bridge courses.
13. The pass percentage for the subjects will be the same i.e. 40% as mentioned in DAE Assessment & Promotion Rules.

14. PBTE will issue certificate to the qualifying candidates to fulfil the requirement of IBCC so that the students can apply for equivalence of Level-3 Diploma of City & Guilds with DAE / HSSC (Pre-engg. Group).
15. If City & Guilds becomes responsive, it would be affiliated with PBTE for examination of its students of Level-3. It will deposit Rs. 50000/- in Board's accounts for such affiliation. In case of affiliation, the City & Guilds shall send cases of its students for registration and examination of bridge courses. Otherwise, the students will be dealt with directly by PBTE.

As far as MOU is concerned, there is no need of it because the competent authority i.e., PBTE Board, in this regard has laid down principles, procedures and rules.

It is requested that according to above mentioned procedure, necessary steps may be taken without further delay please.
