Who We are?

The Punjab Board of Technical Education is a statutory body established under the Punjab Board of Technical Education (Amended) Act, 1977. It is a corporate body to control, develop and regulate Technical, Commercial and Vocational Education as well as Trade and Skill courses up-to Diploma level in the Province of Punjab. PBTE conducts examinations for **195** different courses of Technical, Commercial and Vocational streams. For the purpose of examination **772** institutes from public and private sectors are affiliated with the Board. There are **350** employees who are working in various branches of the Board.

Thrust Area?

PBTE is re-engineering its examination and management system. The PBTE intends to modernize student's assessment procedures by standardizing the processes of test construction and scoring. The system of examination will gradually be shifted from paper pencil testing to online testing. For this purpose PBTE seeks to engage testing and evaluation consultant to develop a computerized examination system for DAE (Electronics) Technology. The consultant institution will develop table of specifications, item/question banks, IT based paper setting/marking, development of computer based testing system, software development and procurement of hardware equipment. PBTE also expects from consultant institution to develop PBTE team for smooth and 100 % secure transition from paper pencil testing to computer based testing.

What are we Looking for?

PBTE invites Expression of Interest from academic institution, universities or consultants who have a clear record of successful completion of similar projects. The applicants should have a team of foreign qualified in the field of educational testing and evaluation. Following documents should be attached with the application / Expression of Interest:

- ❖ Institutional profile with proof of valid legal status i.e. registration with SEC or Registrar of Firms, etc.
- ❖ CVs of principal staff reflecting M.Phil/Ph.D degrees and experience in testing and evaluation.
- ❖ Meaningful partnership with national consulting institution in case of foreign institution.
- ❖ Undertaking that the institution has not been blacklisted or debarred by any Govt / Semi-Govt organization.
- ❖ Evidence of firms past experience vouching for re-engineering and improvement of examination system.
- ❖ Detailed technical proposal and financial proposal (both in a separate sealed cover).
- ❖ Contact Information.
