## NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of the notification issued by P-TEVTA vide communiqué No. TEVTA / Acad/Cur./6-138/(Inter/DAE) & in the light of recommendation of The Committee of Chairmen and Director Technical Education (CCDTE) under agenda no. 08 in its 69<sup>th</sup> meeting and subsequent approval of Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC) in its 176<sup>th</sup> meeting dated 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>, July, 2023 regarding inclusion of the subject of Tarjuma-tul-Quran as a separate subject of 50 marks, this office is hereby pleased to notify that in concerned TVET courses including DAE the same shall be offered in the respective Scheme of Studies. However, in the DAE the subject shall be included in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year only. It shall be implemented with effect from current academic session 2023-2024.

It is reiterated that in order to provide equal opportunity to the students of other religions; \*Religious Education, in lieu of Islamiyat (Islamic Studies) (1<sup>st</sup> Year) with 50 marks whereas Ethics/Civics in lieu of Tarjuma-tul-Quran (1<sup>st</sup> Year & 2<sup>nd</sup> Year) with 50 marks each shall be offered in the scheme of studies of D.Com/ DBA, DDM and Hospitality Sector Courses (having equivalency with relevant intermediate); whereas, in DAE 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year, Civics in lieu of Tarjuma-Tul-Quran will be offered with 50 marks each.

It is also clarified for the information of all concerned that this decision will be applicable only on fresh students of 1<sup>st</sup> year, admitted this year (2023) and not on students already promoted to 2<sup>nd</sup> year.

Under the power delegated by the Board vide notification No: PBTE/R&D/2020/90 dated 28-02-2020, the Chairman, PBTE has been pleased to adopt and approve the above mentioned decision for its implementation in PBTE w.e.f the academic session 2023-2024.

**\*Note:** In the light of decision of Punjab Boards Committee of Chairmen (PBCC), the Non-Muslim students will be awarded the same marks in the subject of Religious Education as of Ethics (other than DAE) in case the books of Religious Education are not printed / provided by The Punjab Curriculum & Textbook Board Lahore. The obtained percentage marks of the subject of Islamiyat (Islamic Studies) for the students of Diploma in Special Education will be replicated against the subject of Tarjuma-tul-Quran.
